






2) and follows a leader blindly,

relatively no capital at all, yet as
we have not been successful to
accumulate money, we are not
favorably regarded by capitalists.

Really unless done on a large
scale there is little to be earned
in coffee. 1st because the competition
is so sharp, that profits are very small
and good customers that pay their bills
are hard to get. 2nd because, coffee is
only coffee, and one coffee or another
is accepted with indifference by
consumers that is to say roasted
coffee. In order to stimulate trade
one has to have salesmen and advertise
which takes large capital. Green
coffee, again takes even more capital
as it is sold for cash in countries
of growth and speculation governs
the profit or loss. I have endeavored
to get a little capital loaned at interest
to run this small business safely and
then to obtain a position for myself
on salary and commission to sell
for others raw merchandise or what not.

3) Considerable business experience in leading articles qualify me for a position of this kind. Up to this writing no chance has arisen to accomplish this intention though I have interviewed friends and acquaintances to no avail.

Capital follows a name and exacts large and immediate returns. The cost of rent in New York is so enormous that only the rich should live here. We have a long lease here and the place has space enough, if we can pay the rent depends on earning \$6000 per annum. Hence the rent would cost no more should we do 20 times the business and the place would be still large enough. With a large business, rents and such expenses do not figure up relatively but a trifle. Profits are large in the United States where large capital is employed but small affairs are immensely difficult. We live in hopes as we are doing the best we can with bad health that has upset me for the past few years. Am using a German suppository lately that seems to improve the condition of parts. The Expense of money and time to go to hospital for operation

14) is too great. A few weeks will determine whether we can obtain capital enough to struggle on. Hence whatever happens we must stand it. Brought your boxes here so that if you need them again in hope to be here to return them to you.

Eu sou um "inventor americano". O jornal não obteve a última correspondência, tanto (então) eu envio agora.

Faço acima um esboço preliminar da presente casa agora ocupada onde como toda New York o estado real anual é caro. Há espaço para desenvolver um grande negócio com capital suficiente para alcançá-la. Estou fazendo esforços frenéticos para obter vantagem, com hipoteca na qual pequeno negócio (merchandise) e bens imóveis que nós possuímos, um pequeno capital conserva o negócio. Mas o capital é limitado e segue um líder "cegamente", como um bando de ovelhas - então, bom ou mau. A despeito do fato (...), nós pagamos nossos débitos e despesa, a qual teve um aumento de \$5000 por ano, relativamente sem capital nenhum, ainda que nós não estamos sendo bem sucedidos para acumular dinheiro. Nós não estamos favoravelmente considerados pelos capitalistas.
